### First PhD Workshop in Money and Finance

The Center for Monetary Policy and Financial Stability (CeMoF) at Stockholm University and the Research Division at Sveriges Riksbank will organize a joint workshop for PhD students, to be held at the Riksbank on May 18<sup>th</sup> 2022. The workshop offers PhD students the possibility to present papers within the fields of monetary policy and financial stability. Each presentation will be followed by a discussion given by a researcher from CeMoF or the Riksbank.

We welcome theoretical as well as empirical papers, and will consider both completed papers and preliminary drafts. Submissions of papers written solely by PhD students are particularly encouraged. Papers will be selected by the organizing committee, which consists of Niklas Amberg (Sveriges Riksbank), Daria Finocchiaro (Sveriges Riksbank, CeMoF), Kurt Mitman (IIES, CeMoF), Ulf Söderström (Sveriges Riksbank, CeMoF) and Roine Vestman (Stockholm University, CeMoF). Authors will be notified of the committee's decision by April 10<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at the latest.

Martin Floden, deputy governor at Sveriges Riksbank, will give a keynote speech. Submissions should be made by sending the paper in PDF format to [phdworkshop@riksbank.se](mailto:phdworkshop@riksbank.se). The submission deadline is March 27<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Travel and accommodation costs will be covered by the workshop organizers for presenters not based in the Stockholm area.
