# The Riksbank's anniversary conference 25 May – central banks in the past, present and future

This year Sveriges Riksbank celebrates its 350th anniversary. The Riksbank and the Riksdag are therefore organising an anniversary conference on the theme "Central banks in the past, present and future". The hosts are the Speaker of the Riksdag Urban Ahlin, Chairperson of the General Council of the Riksbank Susanne Eberstein and Governor of the Riksbank Stefan Ingves.

The morning session, which is held in Swedish, is about the role of central banks in society, how this role has changed over time and what challenges lie ahead of us.

The afternoon session, which is held in English, will begin with a presentation of the Riksbank's anniversary book "Sveriges Riksbank and the History of Central Banking". After that there will be a panel discussion concerning the role of central banks in the future.
