



HOW DO I ACCESS A SUBSCRIPTION KEY?


This document contains information on how to access a subscription key. In the last part of the document there is also some information on troubleshooting.

Access a subscription key


To access a subscription key, go to: <https://developer.api-test.riksbank.se/>

If you already have an account, go direct to step number 5. If you don't have an account start with the steps 1 below.

1. Select "Sign Up"



2. Fill in your details and the captcha.





4. Click on the link in the activation email, this will take you to the “Sign In” page. Now you have an account and can proceed to step 5 and log in with your details.


5. Select "Sign In" and log in with your details.



For example, you can now view your profile.




6. Go to "Products".









10. You should now be able to, for example, curl to the /ping endpoint in the "Payment Statistics API" by specifying the header "**Ocp-Apim-Subscription-Key**" along with your subscription key. **Note** that you must also have a bearer token ("Authorization: Bearer").

The command uses curl to make a GET request to the specified URL, including the Ocp-Apim-Subscription-Key header and a Bearer token header, and prints the JSON response {"message": "pong"} to the console.

Troubleshooting

Example 1.

```
"statusCode": 401,  
"message": "Access denied due to missing subscription key.  
Make sure to include subscription key when making requests  
to an API."
```

- This probably means that you are missing a subscription key in the call. For example, "Ocp-Apim-Subscription-Key" may be misspelled.

Example 2.

```
"statusCode": 401,  
"message": "Access denied due to invalid subscription key.  
Make sure to provide a valid key for an active  
subscription."
```

- This probably means that you have a subscription key in the call but that it is not valid. For example, the subscription key has expired or is for a different product.

Example 3.

```
"statusCode": 403 Forbidden
```

- This likely means that your bearer token is invalid. For example, it has expired or has incorrect content.
